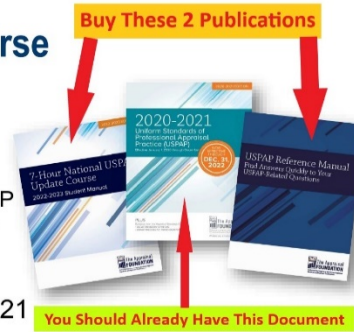


## 7-Hour National USPAP Course
